In 2010 I was nominated for four ONYA awards, when three of my websites were finalists in the categories of *Best Accessibility*, *Best use of HTML and CSS* and *Best Content (personal)* - and in the HTML/CSS category two out of the three finalists were sites I had built.

 - Hand-coding to an extremely high level of accessibility and full W3C validity, following NZ e-government Guidelines (WCAG 2.0)
 - Incorporating existing jQuery effects as progressive enhancement
 - Extensive browser/OS testing of the site at all stages of the dev process including the creation of a fully browser-tested CSS print stylesheet
 - Setting up a local version of the site on my Mac using MAMP and Versions so that I could integrate my work seamlessly into the Chrometoaster version
 - Close teamwork to ensure consistency, minimise the chances of overwriting each other's code, and to ensure that the templates worked well in Drupal.

Summary The job was divided into modular elements incorporated into the templates, produced in a series of phases. These were delivered to HeadFirst on an ongoing basis for integration, with any tweaking also being carried out at the same time.

Summary This was a great (and tricky) design to work on, which required some clever thinking in terms of the HTML structure and the CSS, which I always enjoy. It was important to maintain close communications with NIWA and the Squiz team, to ensure that my templates could be integrated easily and pixel-perfectly into the CMS.

Summary It took me a year to design, build and write enough of the site to get it online - and soon after it went live I was contacted by Radio New Zealand who had been inspired by my work to create a documentary entitled *The Gatherers*. It's impossible for anyone to have a complete picture of even one party, let alone six, so I have made the site as inclusive as possible, encouraging visitors to make submissions of all kinds in order to grow the site.

 - Once the website was launched, I suggested areas within the site that could be developed, all of which I then created - these included *Kiwi at Night*, *Weird & Wonderful Kiwi Facts*, *The Life-Cycle of the Kiwi* and *Kiwi Evolution*
 - Research into, and writing the content of these new sections, in consultation with DoC kiwi researchers. After leaving CWA I was contracted (at the request of the BNZ) to write and develop new sections as required.

Summary It was hard to let this one go when I left CWA as I had put so much work and so many of my own ideas into this one. The design included a double-framed architecture with a new frameset needed for every page. I taught myself how to do frames with this website - certainly an interesting challenge.
