Summary This was a great (and tricky) design to work on, which required some clever thinking in terms of the HTML structure and the CSS, which I always enjoy. It was important to maintain close communications with NIWA and the Squiz team, both to ensure that my templates could be integrated easily into the CMS, and also to ensure they had sufficient information to create a pixel-perfect rendition of these templates within the CMS.

Summary In phase 2 I was responsible for integrating the new templates into WordPress, and not being an expert in PHP I had to do quite a bit of research and learn fast. I'm particularly pleased that my dogged determination to "make it work" resulted in the proper display of current navigation and subnavigation elements – something that we hadn't achieved initially.

Summary The timeframe for this large number of templates was very tight, so the build process needed to be as efficient as possible. I re-used page elements wherever possible in order to speed up the process. The high level of accessibility and e-govt compliance added to the complexity of the build, as did the implementation of various interactive Flash elements. The site is multi-lingual and includes blogs, videos and student stories, all of which had to be included in the template build. At the time, this set of templates was by far the most complex I had ever built, and I loved every minute of it.

Brief To re-skin the site's master templates by changing the CSS, rebuilding the header and footer HTML, and building a new homepage. The new intranet comes in four different colourways and the contents are fully editable by the TNZ staff intranet team.

 - Reskinning the TNZ master templates to match the new design in pure CSS
 - Rebuilding the header and footer sitewide and building a new homepage
 - Coding to a reasonable level of accessibility and e-govt compliance
 - Although TNZ uses IE exclusively, I felt it was important to bring the existing HTML/CSS into line with compliant browsers such as Firefox, as well as ensuring that the site would look as good in IE7 as it did in IE6
 - Extensive testing for cross-browser consistency and W3C validation
 - Working with the programmer to ensure easy implementation within Shado
 - Reiteration of some aspects of the CSS after integration, in order to achieve a consistent look and feel on pages where the existing HTML was being affected by the new CSS, but which could not be changed.

Summary It was an interesting challenge to achieve the design by only changing the CSS. The four colourways were achieved using separate stylesheets and I had a great deal of fun thinking outside the box in order to replicate the design perfectly.

Summary It took me a year to design, build and write enough of the site to get it online - and soon after it went live I was contacted by Radio New Zealand who had been inspired by my work to create a documentary entitled *The Gatherers*.
 It's impossible for anyone to have a complete picture of even one party, let alone six, so I have made the site as inclusive as possible, encouraging visitors to make submissions of all kinds in order to grow the site.
